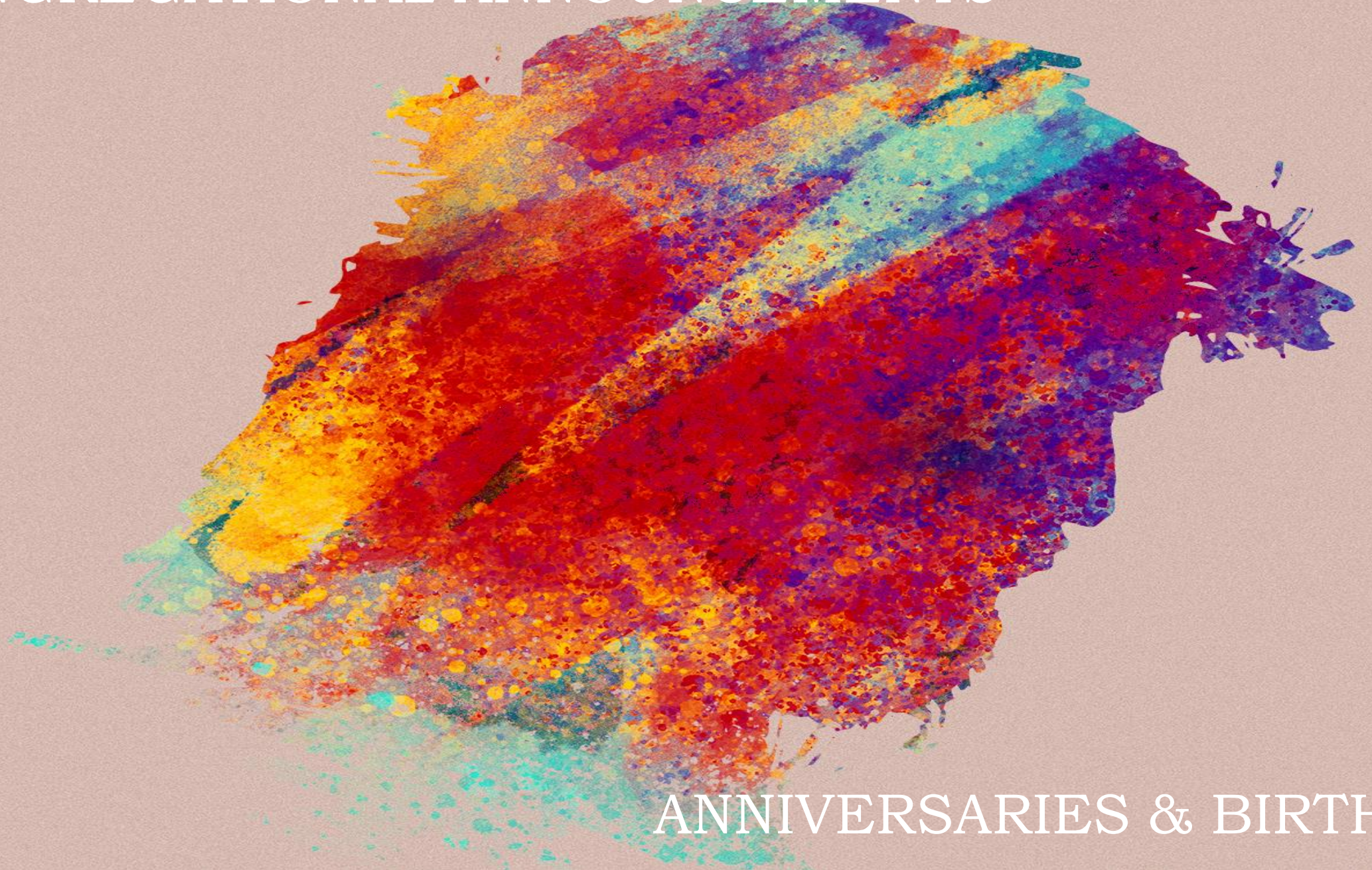

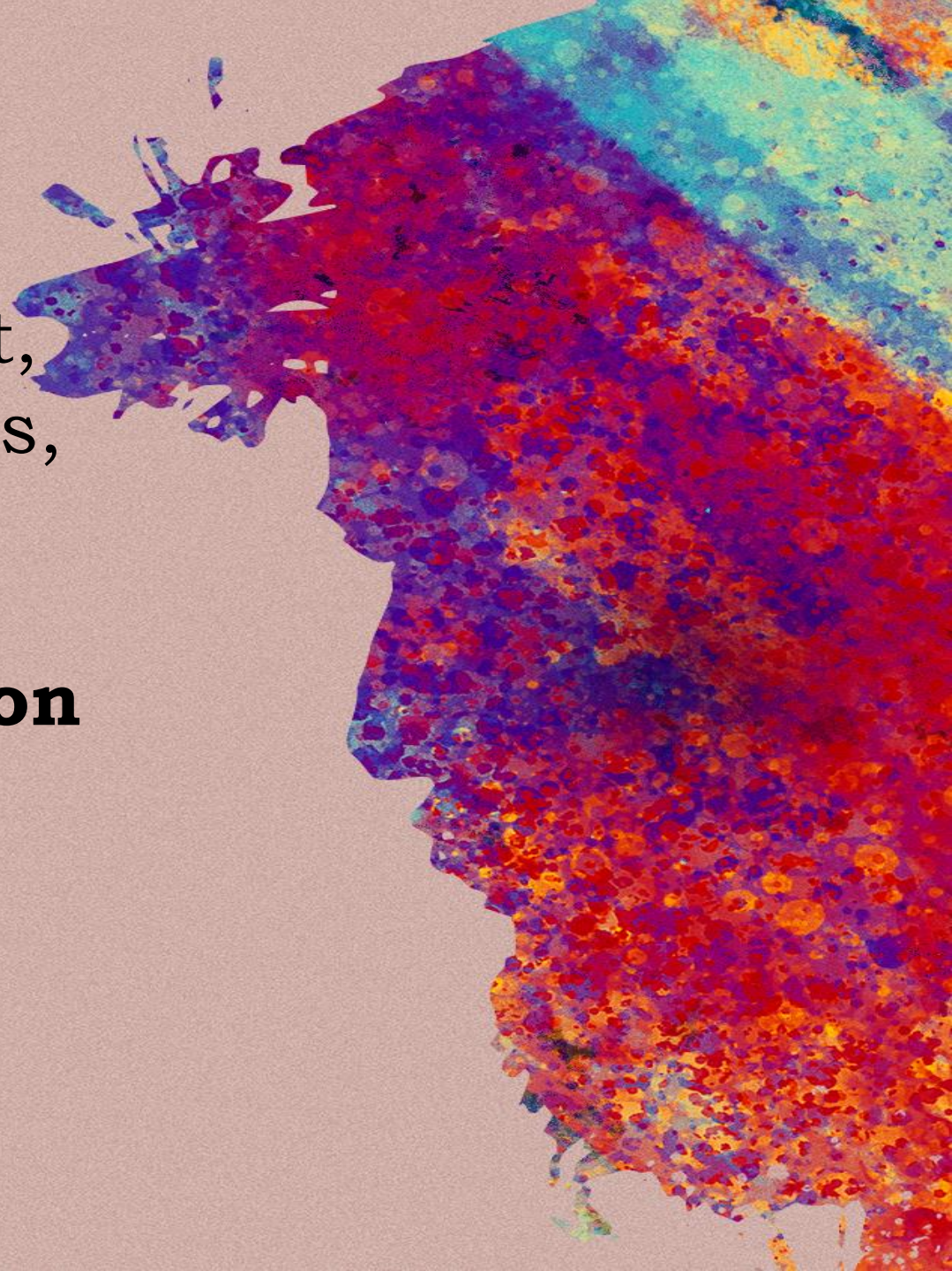
GREETING

people.**



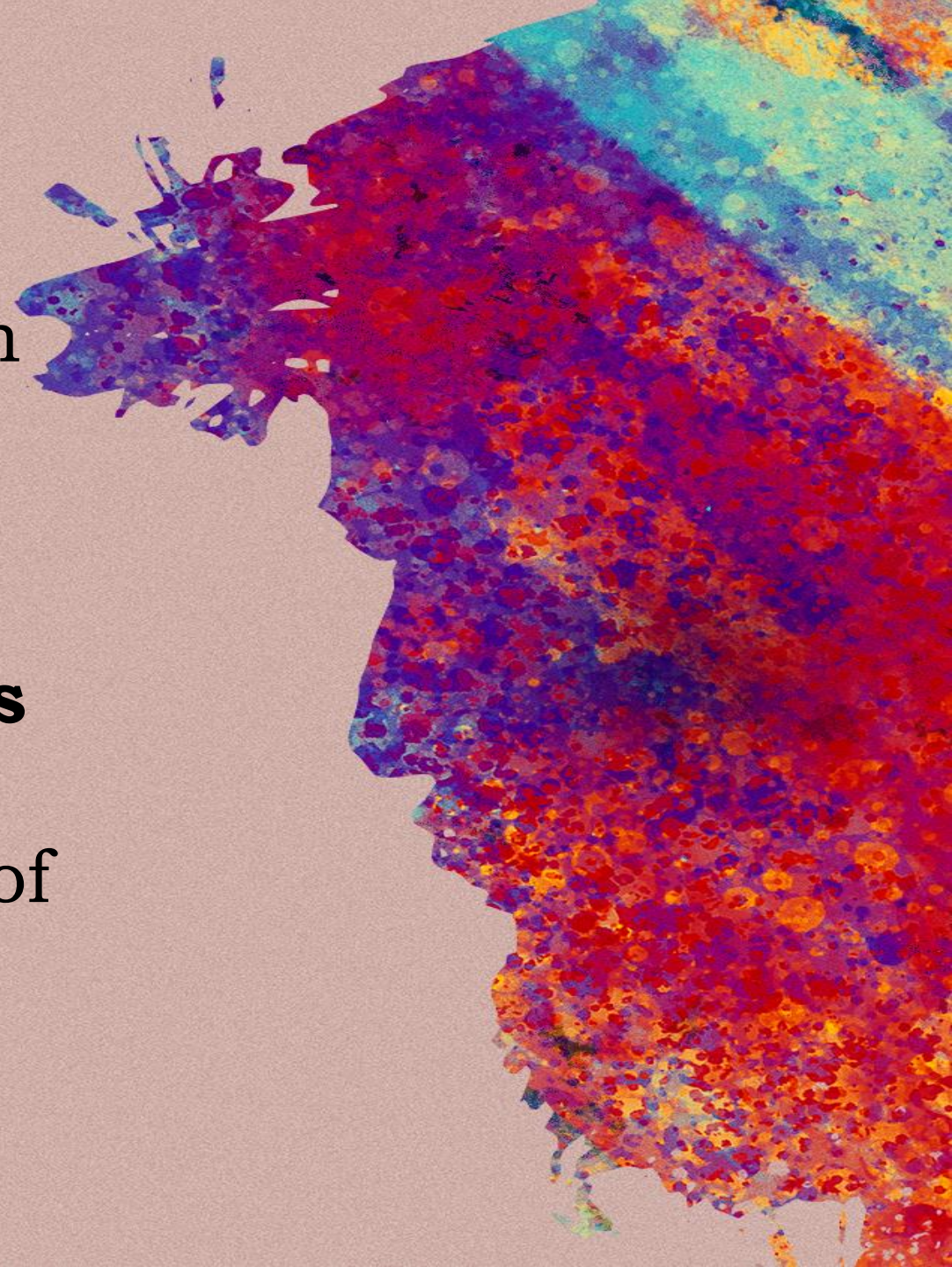
GREETING (Continued)

Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful.

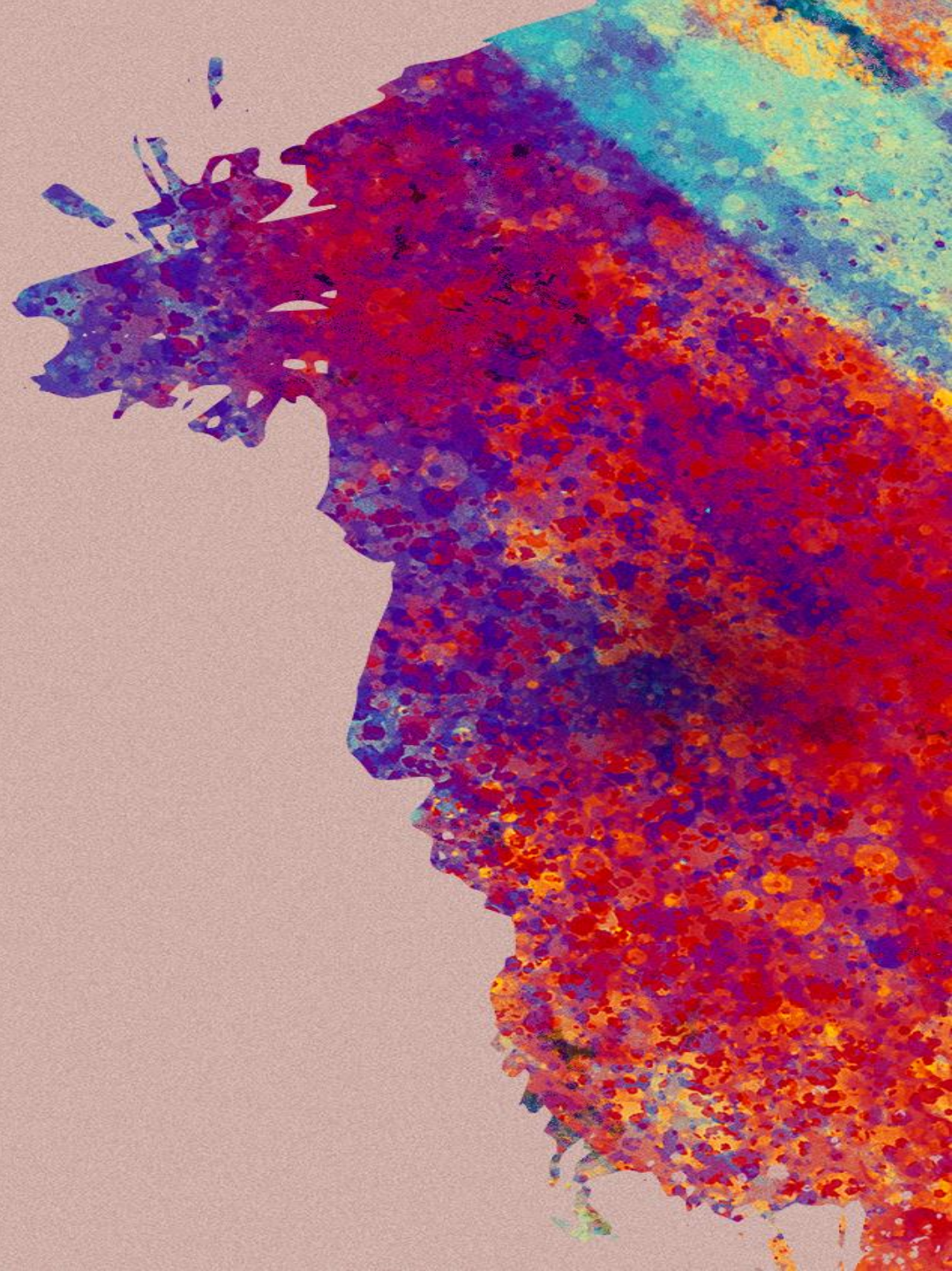





me;


I heard about his groaning, of his precious blood's

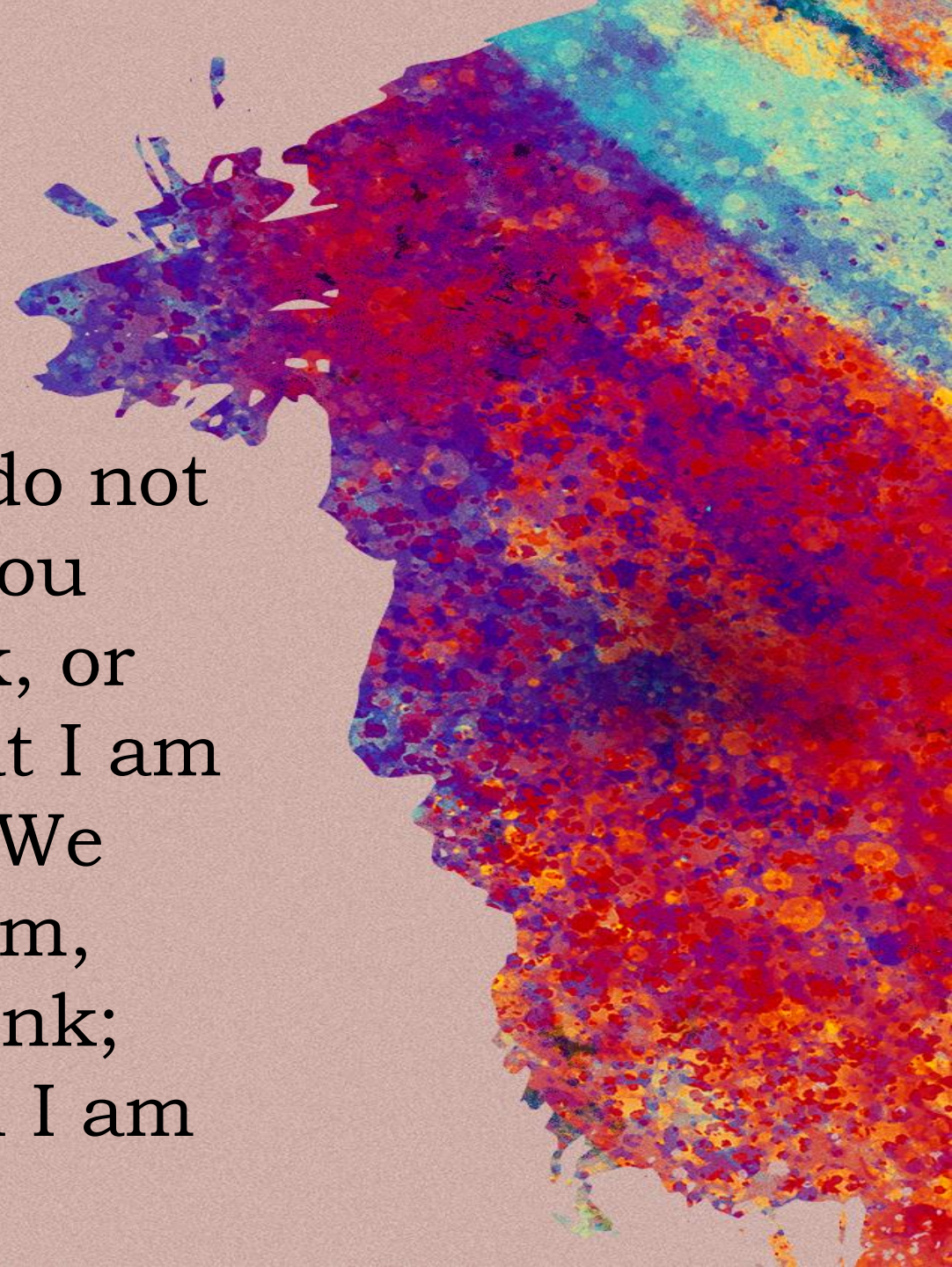
GOSPEL: Mark 10:35-45

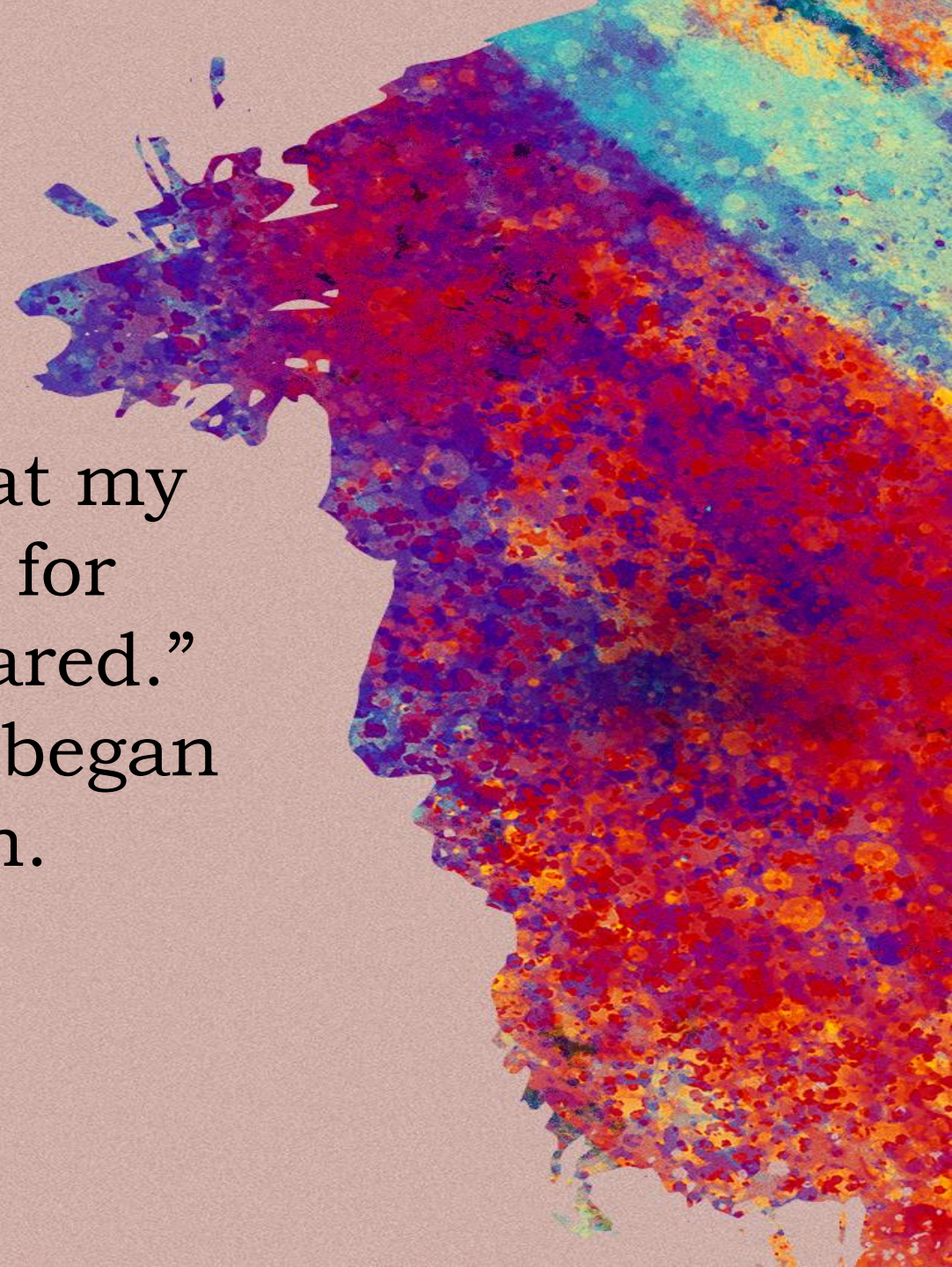

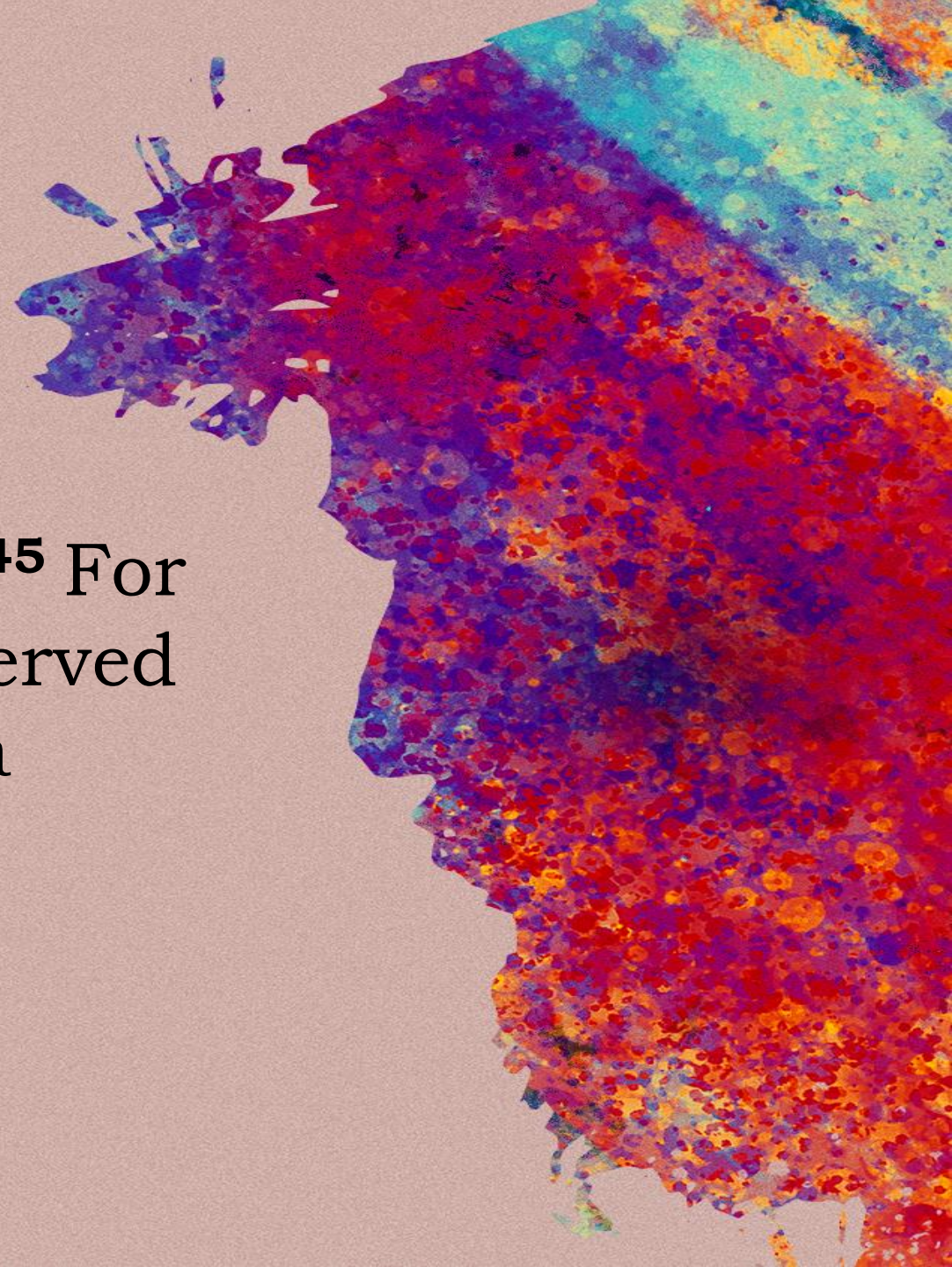
