
All thy works with joy surround thee,

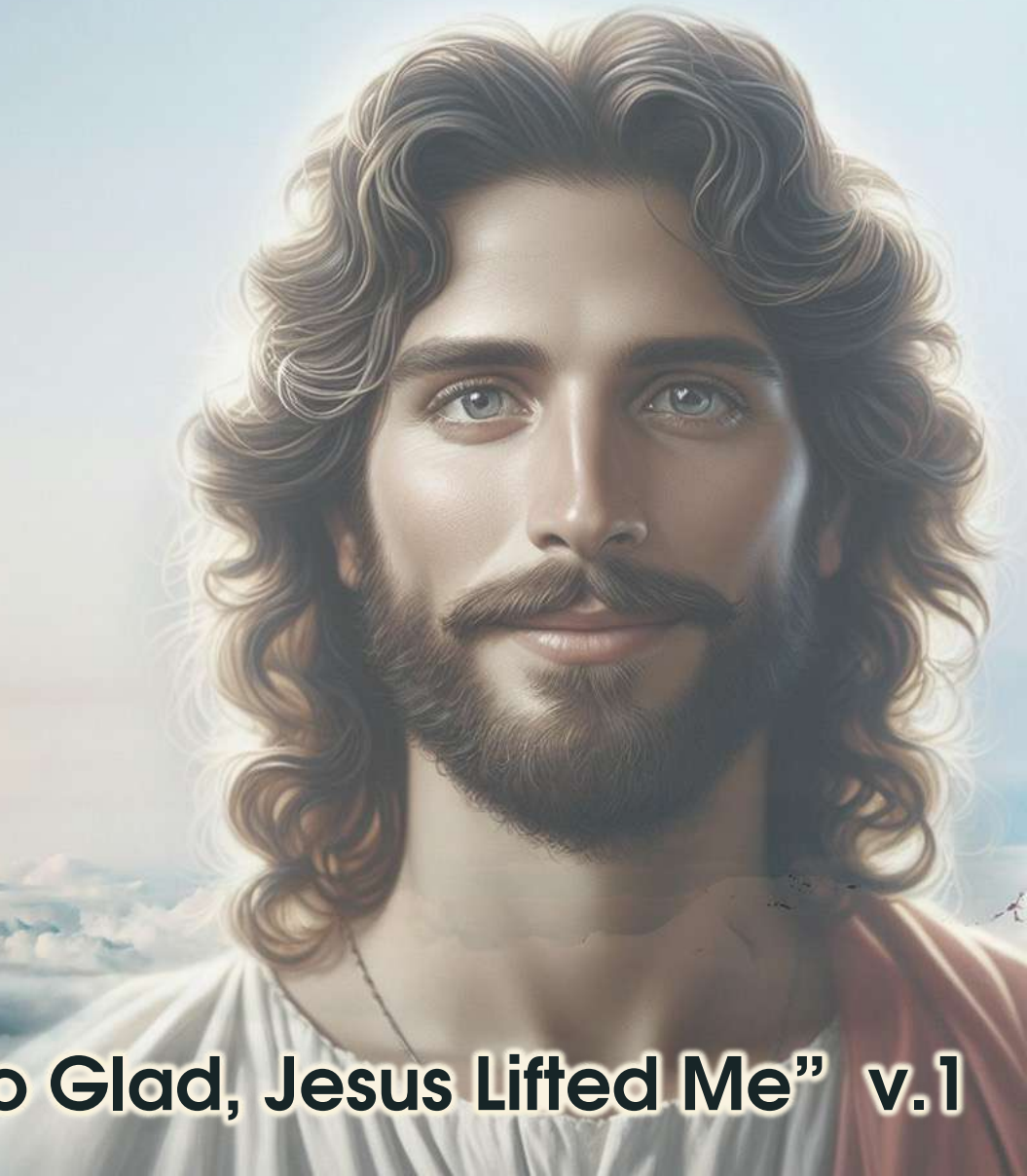

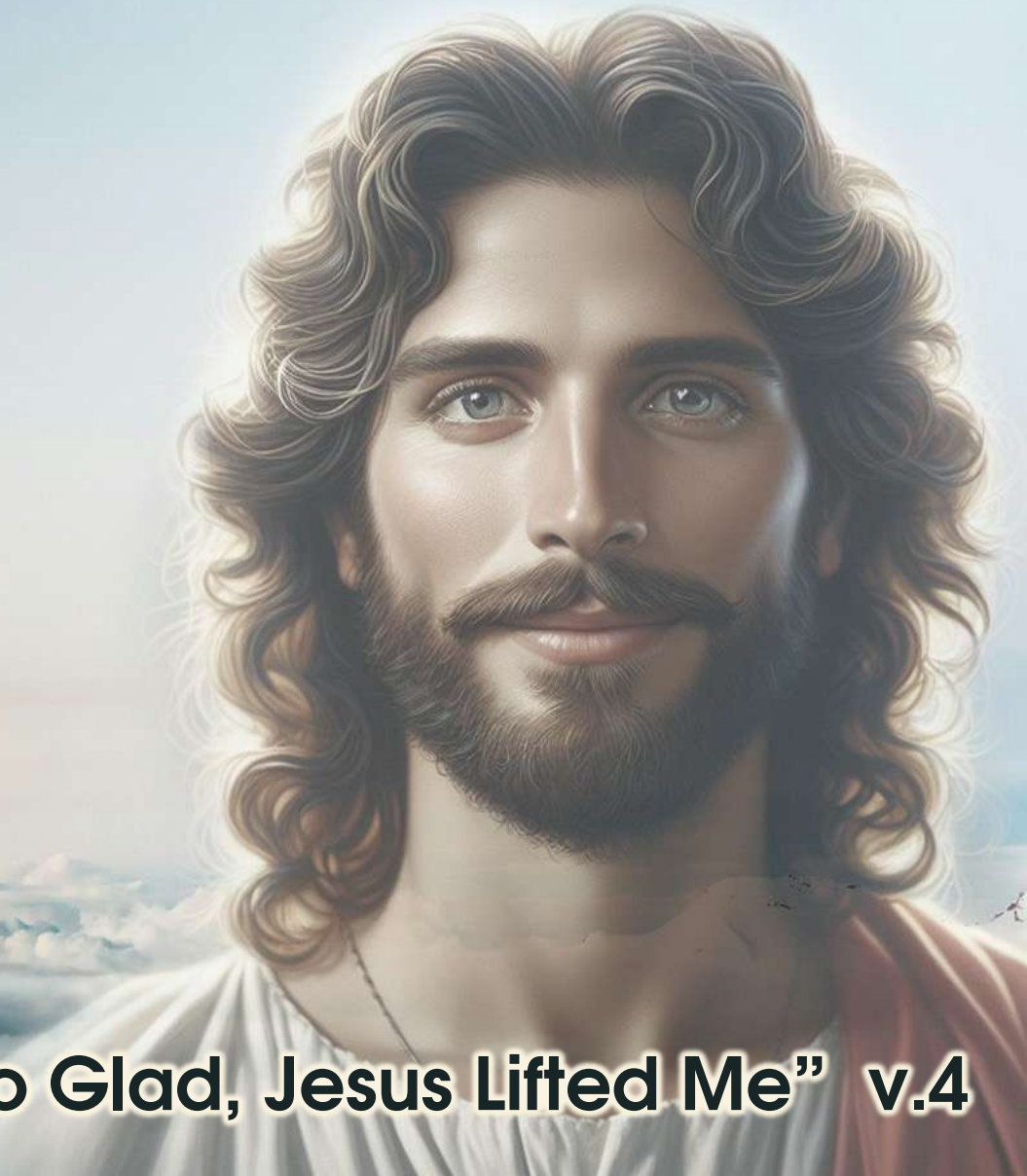
